“CROSS WORDS”

The seven weeks of Lent are devoted to reflecting on the suffering and death of Christ. But Lent is also a good time to hear afresh the words of the Lord. As Jesus said: “The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life” (John 6:63). This Lenten season we will give attention to those of life that Jesus spoke while in the midst of death. These seven last words from the cross are His “cross words.”

The last words of Jesus provide us an insight and understanding into those things that He thought most important: Forgiveness, Eternal Life, Family, Suffering, and more. These words, which are usually reserved for Good Friday, will be a great guide for our understanding of Jesus’ Passion and death for us. This preparation will help to make Easter a much more joyous occasion.

Our mid-week Lenten services will be every Wednesday at 7:00 p.m. The “Cross Words” theme will follow this schedule:

Ash Wednesday (Feb. 10): “Father, Forgive Them”

Lent 1 (Feb. 17): “You Will Be With Me in Paradise”

Lent 2 (Feb. 24): “Behold Your Son; Behold Your Mother”

Lent 3 (March 2): “My God, Why Have You Forsaken Me?”

Lent 4 (March 9): “I Thirst”

Lent 5 (March 16): “It Is Finished”

Maundy Thursday (March 24): “Father, Into Your Hands I Commend My Spirit”

On Good Friday (March 25), we will once again follow our service of Tenebrae and our Easter celebration will begin with the Easter Vigil on Saturday, March 26.

I pray that you will join us in this journey to the cross of Christ so that we can rejoice in His resurrection that much more on Easter Sunday.

MISSION GIVING FOR 2016

As you may have noticed, there was no “Grateful Giving” program outlined in last month’s *Messiah Messenger*. Our mission giving has been updated and streamlined so that it is more in line with biblical principles of stewardship. In 2016, Messiah’s mission giving will be **intentional**. We will focus on regular gifts to fewer ministries instead of the lesser gifts that were given to many ministries. Likewise, our mission giving will be **proportional**. Our gifts will not be whatever loose money may be found in the offering plates but will, instead, be a percentage of the total *regular* offerings of Messiah Lutheran Church.

Following these principles, this is what the Mission Giving for Messiah looks like in 2016.

The **Michigan District** will receive 5% of our regular offerings, which is estimated at \$15,000 for the year. This will aid the District as they support ministry throughout our state and start new missions in Michigan and abroad.

The **Mid-Michigan Lutheran High School Association** will receive 2% of our regular offerings, which is estimated at \$6,000 for the year. When Messiah voted to become a member of this association, it incurred a \$5,000 per year association fee. Due to some miscommunication, Messiah did not pay this fee for the 2014-15 school year so we are one year in arrears to our commitment. This offering will go to meet our commitment to the MMLHSA and support the great work they are doing in Lutheran secondary education. Also, in an effort to catch up on our commitment, each month’s “**Joyful Noise/ Noisy Offering**” will also be going to the MMLHSA, which will add an estimated \$1,000 per year. With these two offerings, we should fulfill our commitment in 2-3 years.

Youth Haven Ranch in Rives Junction will receive 1% of our regular offerings, which is estimated at \$3,000 for the year. For over 15 years, Messiah has supported Youth Haven Ranch through our Forts and Sorts Servant Event and Christmas in-gatherings of toys, games, and clothes. Many of our lives have been touched by the great work that Youth Haven does with underprivileged and disadvantaged kids in our area. This is a way that we can increase their work.

This year, these offerings will total 8% of our offerings at Messiah. In 2017, our goal will be 10% mission giving and we will need your help. Our District and MMLHSA giving will remain the same but we want to give you a chance to decide the last three ministries we will support throughout the year. Coming in October, we will give you a chance to tell us about great Christian ministries that you think Messiah should support. We will put all of those great ministries before the voters in our November

meeting and the top three selections will get 1% of Messiah's offering for 2017 to support their work.
